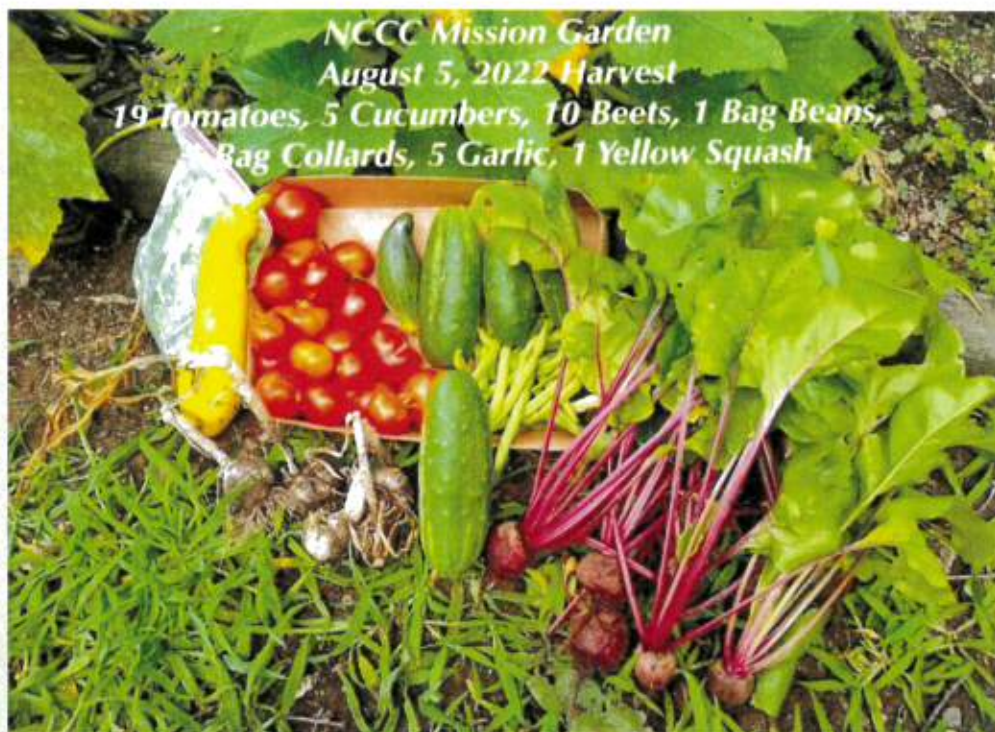

Matt is the Artistic Director Of The University Of Akron's Steel Drum Band. His arrangements and original compositions have been featured both in performance and on the band's recordings. Part of his duties at the University of Akron include teaching an arranging class for steel drums and private lessons.

In 2002, Matt traveled to Trinidad to get a first-hand look at the home of pan, and was able to perform during Panorama with the Invaders Steelband. In 2010, Matt travelled again to Trinidad and Tobago, as executive director for "Hammer on Steel," a DVD and PBS broadcast which was nominated for 8 Emmy awards.

Matt is a percussionist with the Akron Symphony Orchestra and works with several schools and musical organizations in NE Ohio.
