

LENTEN FOOD **COLLECTION**

Nearly 200 pounds of food. So far, NCCC has donated:



52 lbs.—cereal 79 lbs.—soup & stew 53 lbs.-canned tuna That comes to 184 lbs. of food. Because some of the categories have

changed, it's hard to compare weekly totals between this year and last. For example, last year when canned soup was separate from beef stew, you donated 150 pounds of the canned items (Week 5—67 lbs. of stew, week 6—83 lbs. soup). But, what we can compare are the totals of the first three Sundays. In 2023 you donated 152 lbs. of food. Last week's collection keeps NCCC on track for donating more than 400 lbs. of food to the Akron Canton Regional Foodbank.

This week, the focus of the Lenten Super 6 Food Collection is macaroni and cheese. I didn't see any good sales for macaroni and cheese worth mentioning. Week 6, we'll collect peanut butter, which is on sale at Marc's until Tuesday (16 oz. Jif peanut butter for \$2.50/jar).

Please note, a volunteer is still needed to take the peanut butter to the foodbank.
